Wijkasteel Haksberg – Virido | Belgische wijn Pinot Noir–Auxerrois Belgium (België) – 2020

Domain

Wijkasteel Haksberg

Wijkasteel Haksberg is an extensive domain of woodland and parkland in the Hageland, with a small castle from the 19th century, a wine terrace, rolling vineyards and good Belgian wine. The wines have recently won awards in the low countries and are therefore better known. The name of the wines always refers to (the Latin name of) a bird that has been spotted on the domain. The vineyard has traditional grape varieties such as Dornfelder, Auxerrois, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. They work according to the principle of integrated crop protection.

Vinification

The harvest is done manually. The wine is fermented at a low temperature, which means that the process takes longer and there is more time for aromatic and aromatic substances to develop. The aging of the wine takes from October to May.

Taste

Virido is a dry, aromatic white wine with white stone fruit such as peach, citrus fruit and green apple on the nose. Fresh in the mouth, with notes of white stone fruit and grapefruit.
