

Wijnfiche Château Trotanoy | Pomerol France (POMEROL) — 2011

Domain

Ch. Trotanoy

Château Trotanoy is located in Libourne, Pomerol one kilometer west of Pétrus. The winery first had the name "Trop Ennuie" and was owned by the Girauds family. This family changed the name to "Trotanoy" and since 1953 the winery is owned by Jean-Piere Moueix. The winery has around 12 hectares of vineyard and produces 42,000 bottles annually.

Vinification

The grapes are picked by hand and after sapling the juice is vinified in cement tubs. The wine is then raised on barriques, half of which is renewed annually.

Taste

On the nose we experience aromas of cherries, violets, truffle and tobacco. Trotanoy has power, complexity and depth, but at the same time the velvety texture that makes Pomerol so attractive. The price-quality ratio of this great wine remains unique.
