Pura Vina - Paraje Norte | D.O. Bullas Monastrell Spain (MURCIA) — 2021

Domain

Pura Viña

The estate currently comprises 8 hectares of vineyards but is continually expanding. Strategically located vineyards are being acquired, but only if they possess the capabilities to produce grapes with the desired characteristics. Situated at an altitude of 900 meters, the vineyards benefit from a Mediterranean climate, contributing to the finesse of both Garnacha and Monastrell varieties.

Vinification

The vines are rooted in dolomitic limestone and are oriented perpendicular to the sun. After harvest, traditional vinification follows with an 8-month aging period in 400-liter French oak barrels.

Taste

This Paraje Norte is the flagship wine of the Pura Viña estate. Although Monastrell has a reputation for being a blockbuster, this Paraje Norte, with its subtle freshness, proves otherwise. It is distinctly mineral, juicy, and has depth in the finish, making it an attractive choice for connoisseurs of Spanish wine!
